- 1. Your information pack is sent when your deposit has been received by Kokoda Trekking. Please open the information package on your computer for Information PDF files. The files contain information regarding your trek.**
- 2. The Trekking Fees need to be paid 60 Days prior to your trek start date. The costs to include "Trekking Costs & Porter Costs". The Porter Costs are if you are having a personal Porter.**
- 3. The Doctor's Certificate is to state that you are fit enough to walk the Kokoda Track. Please consult your local GP for certificate.**
- 4. Please advise your flight and accommodation details to us.**
- 5. A tourist Visa can be obtained prior to your departure by contacting the PNG Consultate closest to where you live or you can obtain a "Tourist Visa" on arrival at customs in Port Moresby.**
- 6. Local Currency can be obtained from your banks in Australia if they are given prior notice. You can also obtain Currency at Brisbane Airport currency exchange or alternatively you can do so in Port Moresby using the bank located at the airport inside the customs area.**
- 7. Please advise family members of all trip details. Family members can view your progress through our website as you walk the Kokoda Track. The front page of the website has a news section where they can see your trek number. If they open up this forum post they can see your progress. Although pictures we add are usually from the start of your trek and cannot be updated further until the end as Internet is not available to send pictures back for updates but we let your family and friends know how your trek is progressing.
