- 1. Your information pack is sent when your deposit has been received by Kokoda Trekking. Please open the information package on your computer for Information PDF files. The files contain information regarding your trek.**
- 2. Your final payment is required 60 days prior to your trek start date. This payment is made up of the total cost of your trek, less your deposit of \$500.00 along with the cost of your personal porter should you choose to hire one.**
- 3. The Doctor's Certificate is to state that you are fit enough to walk the Kokoda Track. Please consult your local GP for certificate.**
- 4. Please provide your flight arrival and departure details. 1 nights accommodation is provided in your package at Sogeri Lodge. If you wish to stay at an alternative hotel, please advise us of the details. Alternate accommodation at Trekkers expense.**
- 5. A tourist Visa can be obtained prior to your departure by contacting the PNG Consulate closest to where you live or you can obtain a "Tourist Visa" on arrival at customs in Port Moresby.**
- 6. Local Currency can be obtained from your banks in Australia if they are given prior notice. You can also obtain Currency at Brisbane Airport currency exchange or alternatively you can do so in Port Moresby using the bank located at the airport inside the customs area.**
- 7. Please advise family members of your trip details. Once your trek has commenced, we put regular updates on our website so anyone can log on and either read and/or post messages. To find the messages, please scroll down on the front page to the news section where they can see your trek number. If they click on the link they can see your progress. Photographs are taken at the start of each trek and our guides carry a camera on the track itself. These can only be uploaded once the camera has made its way back to Port Moresby. - 8. Please make sure you wear your trekking boots on the plane. If your bag goes missing on the flight most things can be replaced locally but not your worn in boots!**
